By 2022 July 15, the FCC is retiring CORES (**C**ommission **R**egistration **S**ystem for the FCC) version 1, CORES version 2. You need to establish a username and password for this new CORES and associate it with your FRN.

Here is the announcement:

To get started, you will need to know your FRN and original password for your FRN. Then go to this website:

<https://apps.fcc.gov/cores/userLogin.do>

Click on “Register” to create a new username (your email address) and password. They will send you an email to confirm your registration.

After you complete the confirmation process you need to log in to that new account and select “Associate Username to FRN” to link this new account with your FRN. Here is where you will need your FRN and original password for the FRN.

Once you have successfully associated your FRN with this new CORES system, I would suggest you click through the “Manage FRNs” links to get to the page that lists your FRN, and then click “Update/View FRN”.
